2.1 INTRODUCTION

The intention of The Solomon Island Swimming Federation (SISF) towards the active promotion and the development of swimming in the Solomon Islands.

2.2 BRIEF HISTORY

The Solomon Island Swimming Federation has been revived back in 2005 from its suspension back in 2005 by Stance Beula Sanga and former executive board with clubs formed and a first ever national championship held in Lunga in 2005, second championship in 2006 in Marine beach in 2007 championship in marine beach 2009 championship in marine, same as 2010 and 2011 and finally in 2012 we gain back recognition from our international federation and they accepted us as a national federation governing aquatics in the Solomon Islands and in 2013 we joined the Honiara team to participate in the Solomon Games as an exhibition, 2014 we did our club with national championship 2015 we joined the youth commonwealth games in Samoa with the Pacific Games in PNG July 14th – 18th 2016 we participate in the Solomon Games with associations from 3 provinces are Guadalcanal, Malaita and Honiara team compete with each other, 2017 Japan with 3 swimmers to train under the JICA in 2018 we participate in the Commonwealth Games in Sydney, Oceania Swimming Championship in PNG, world championship in China Hangzhou led 4x swimmers, 2019 first ever Solomon Island swimmer under FINA Scholarship trained in Thailand, participate in the Arafura Games in Darwin with 2 x able swimmers and 2x para swimmers (1x male, 1 x female), Pacific Games in Samoa 4x athletes with 3 officials, 2 x officials and 2x male athletes attend FINA World Championship in Korea, 2021 Participation at the Olympic Games in Tokyo, 2020 National Championship in Marovo Western Province 2022 Commonwealth Games in Birmingham England world championship in Budapest.

Domestically we keep on striving hard increase our provincial clubs to strengthen them in terms of training and upskilling.

We have participated in the international events, educational programs, certification clinics for coaches, webinars certification clinics for officials, and athletes' educational programs.

The Challenges we face all through these years is no proper facilities, insufficient funds to expansion of provincial associations clubs with trainer coaches volunteering without salaries, proper establishing of clubs in the provincial association and upskilling.
